If you get a message from the list and you hit the REPLY button, you **should** be replying to the PERSON who sent the original email. Please make sure this is what happens before you hit the send button.

If you forget to include the word LIST your email will go to the convenor of that branch or network. Eg [Japanese@mltaq.asn.au](mailto:Japanese@mltaq.asn.au) will go to the Japanese convenor. Go to the end of this document to find out which email addresses can be used to contact people.

MLTAQLIST – All emails to the main list should be aimed at a majority of members if not all. For example if you wish to send an email that only concerns Japanese members then please send it to the **japaneselist**.

If you send an email to a list of which you **aren't a member**, your email will be moderated. That is, you will receive an email telling you that your email needs to be approved and someone will need to approve it before your message will go to the list.

## WANT TO CHANGE YOUR EMAIL ADDRESS OR GO NO MAIL (among other things)

Go to <http://mltaq.asn.au/mailman/listinfo>, click on the list you want to edit (eg mltaqlist), scroll to the bottom of the next page and click on the button **Unsubscribe or Edit Options**. Explore the next page and you will discover all the functions you can adapt to suit your needs. You will need your email and password to get to this page.

If you want to change your email, go to <http://mltaq.asn.au/mailman/listinfo>, log in with your OLD email address and once you have logged in change your email address to the new one.

You can also set up your emails to come to you as a **digest**. This means you will get one (or possibly two) emails per day with all the emails sent to that list included in it. When you do want to set the digest option make sure you go to the bottom of the page and click "Submit my changes". You can also set this globally (for all your lists) if you wish.
